Application Process:

The letter must state how the applicant has been an active member of the North Vancouver Island Chef's Association. Also a letter of reference is required from your employer, chef or mentor. All applications must be submitted online to info@northvancouverislandchefs.com by midnight on April 30, 2017. Any late applications will not be accepted. Recipients will be announced at the June Installation Dinner. Any bursary and scholarships not awarded or accepted may be carried over until the next year.

Competition Award: maximum \$500.00

These funds are in place to support any **active Federation or Junior Member** that is interested in participating in a local or provincial competition. An application must be made for these funds and a letter describing the competition and stating what these funds will be used for including a budget for use of funds i.e.: travel, accommodation, supplies, etc.
